



Opioid Treatment Programs (OTPs) Expanded Services

There have been recent regulatory changes for Opioid Treatment Programs (OTPs).

Effective January 1, 2020 Medicare is expanding benefits to include coverage of Methadone treatment.

Additionally OTP's have the option of providing expanded Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) to include stocking and administering Buprenorphine (Suboxone) and Naltrexone (Vivitrol) for the commercial and Medicare members whose benefits include such services.

These expanded services will be covered by UnitedHealthcare's Behavioral Health Benefit.
